

**NOTICE OF AN ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE APPLICATION FOR A RCRA PERMIT MODIFICATION**

The Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Office of Land Resources received a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Class 2 permit modification application from Aerojet-Rocketdyne, Inc. The permittee requested to increase the amount of reactive waste (D003) they are allowed to treat per year from 475 tons to 675 tons at the thermal treatment area. The request also includes an increase in the amount of reactive waste that can be treated with burn pans from 6,000 pounds per day to 8,000 pounds per day.

DEQ has determined the application, dated May 21, 2024, to be administratively complete. Any future RCRA permitting decision regarding this application that DEQ makes will be under the authority of Arkansas Code Annotated (A.C.A.) Arkansas Hazardous Waste Management Act (A.C.A. §8-7-201 *et seq.*), as amended, and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976, as amended (42 U.S.C. §6901, *et seq.*). This notice of an administratively complete application satisfies the requirements of A.C.A. §8-4-203(d)(1) as referenced by A.C.A §8-7-213.

Interested individuals may review the application and the administrative record at the DEQ Records Management Section located at 5301 Northshore Drive, North Little Rock, AR, 72118. In addition, persons may also review these documents at the Calhoun County Public Library located at 115 South Second Street, Hampton, AR, 71744.

Individuals wishing to comment or request a public hearing regarding the application must submit a written request within ten (10) business days of the date of publication of this notice. The request must be hand-delivered or post marked to the Division by close of business no later than 4:30 p.m. on Oct. 10, 2024. If DEQ determines a public hearing for the application is warranted, then a public hearing will be scheduled. DEQ will notify the applicant and all the persons who have submitted comments of the date, time, and place of the scheduled public hearing by certified mail.
